

Annual Report (2025–26)

National Cadet Corps (Army Wing), LNCT Bhopal

1. On 15 August 2025, the NCC Army Wing of LNCT Bhopal organised an Independence Day Parade and Celebration under the guidance of Major Dr. Yogesh Singh, with the active participation of 75 cadets and students. The event was conducted with great enthusiasm and patriotic spirit to commemorate the nation's Independence Day. Through parade activities, ceremonial participation, and patriotic involvement, the programme successfully instilled national pride, unity, discipline, and respect for freedom among the students, encouraging dedication and responsibility toward the nation.



2. On 15 August 2025, the LNCT Group of Colleges organised a grand Tiranga Yatra on the occasion of the 79th Independence Day under the guidance of Major Dr. Yogesh Singh.
